Prepare your students for their Honors Chorus Auditions by bringing them to this FREE training clinic at UNCG, run by Welborn Young (2005 N.C. All-State Treble Choir conductor).

This clinic is designed for middle school students and their teachers, who are preparing for NCMEA Middle School Honors Chorus auditions on October 6. Dr. Young and several of his advanced vocal/choral students will provide large-group, sectional, and individual training and tips. Areas of work will/may include:

- Vocal technique (diction, intonation, tone quality, etc.)
- Technical accuracy of audition piece (precision of pitches/rhythms)
- Audition techniques (posture, projection, breathing)
- _sight reading (10% of the audition score)

Take advantage of this **free** event! Bring your most advanced students for that "extra polish" they might need. Bring the ones with marginal ability as well. Bring your "on-the-bubble students who just aren't sure yet, or need a little more confidence and assurance. Singers will have the chance to work in large and small groups, and might even get to try some "mock-auditioning" by themselves if they wish. The clinic runs from 9:00 a.m. to 12 noon. Mock Auditions will be held from 12:00 – 1:00 for those students wishing to stay. Please let Bill Young know when you register how many will be staying for those mock auditions. Registration begins at 8:00 a.m.
