The Research Committee is pleased to announce a call for research reports for presentation at a Research Poster Session at the NCMEA In-Service Conference, November 12-15, 2011.

The committee invites submissions from all members of NCMEA and all areas of MENC, nationwide. Authors whose reports are selected will present their research during a research poster session in which interested music educators can learn about the research and discuss applications to music teaching and learning with the authors. Each presenter will prepare a 30" x 40" poster that describes the research and will provide abstracts for interested individuals attending the poster session. Complete instructions for preparing the poster will be sent to each author whose paper is accepted.

To submit a presentation proposal: Prepare an abstract of approximately 750 words that provides a concise, yet thorough, summary of the research project, and submit **an electronic copy pasted directly into the body of an email message** to:
