Rules & Regulations

HONORS CHORUS STUDENTS ARE CHOSEN FROM OVER 1200 AUDITIONS TO FORM THE FINEST HIGH SCHOOL CHORUS IN THE STATE. THE QUALITY OF THEIR PERFORMANCE DEPENDS ON:

1. Thorough preparation of the music before arriving in Winston-Salem and
 2. Maximum self-discipline and cooperation during the two days of rehearsals and performance.

- A. Upon arrival, singers will be placed in quartet formation. At 8:45 AM, all singers will perform the repertoire for the Executive Board of the choral section of NCMEA. This screening will determine if each singer knows all of the music. Should the board pull a singer, this singer is expected to perform the music as a solo (with CD accompaniment) for a screening committee. If the singer is inadequately prepared, the singer will be sent home without reimbursement of hotel or registration fees.
 - B. Singers will be given a nametag to be worn at rehearsals and in the hotel to identify the as NCHS Honors Chorus members and to record their attendance and punctuality.
 - C. Singers must attend every rehearsal, arriving at least fifteen minutes early to have their attendance properly recorded and to be seated.
 - D. As with all North Carolina high school functions, the use of alcohol, tobacco, or illegal drugs will not be tolerated.
 - E. Cell phones should be completely “off” during rehearsals. The Honors Chorus coordinator must approve any extenuating circumstance.
 - F. Singers whose general behavior interferes with rehearsal will be dismissed from the chorus.
 - G. Proper concert attire:
 - a. Ladies: floor length black dress with shoulders completely covered (if in doubt, bring a small cover, sweater, etc.)
 - b. Gentlemen: Black suit or tuxedo.

Failure to comply with any one for the above rules will result in the student’s dismissal from the chorus. The singer’s parents will be notified of dismissal and the need to arrange immediate transportation home. The singer’s school principal will be notified of dismissal.

Each singer, parent, director, and principal should read the rules above and sign below.
